

Charmed Fall Tablerunner

Use some of those favorite fabric collections for this easy project. Charm packs are a good source for this. The pattern is written so you can easily customize the size of the tablerunner.

Project shown size 65" x 25"

Juki Supplies

- Sewing Machine
- ¼" piecing foot
- Standard presser foot

Fabric & Supplies

- 1 pkg Charm Squares (42 - 5" squares)
- ½ yd accent border and binding fabric
- 2/3 main border fabric
- 2 yds backing fabric
- 70" x 30" cotton batting
- Thread for piecing and quilting



Cutting Fabric

- From accent border fabric cut:
 - Four - 1 ½" x WOF strips for accent border
- For binding cut:
 - Five - 2 ½" x WOF strips
- For main border fabric cut:
 - Four - 5" x WOF strips

Assemble Tablerunner Center

1. Arrange the charm squares in rows as desired. Arrange 14 down and 3 across.



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2. Sew the rows of 3 blocks together using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " stitch. Press the seams open.



3. Sew the rows together. Pressing seams open.



Borders

1. Measure the length of the tablerunner for border measurements.
2. Cut and piece the accent border fabric - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips to make:
 - a. Two - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x measurement determined in Step 1.
3. Cut and piece the main border fabric - 5" x WOF strips to make:
 - a. Two - 5" x measurement determined in step 1.

Attach Borders

1. Sew the accent borders to the tablerunner sides, press seams.
2. Sew the main borders to the accent borders, press seams.



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Putting It All Together

1. Layer tablerunner top, batting, and backing. Baste in place by using a spray baste such as 505 or pin in place.
2. Quilt the tablerunner.
Note: This sample was quilted $\frac{1}{4}$ " inside each square and $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the accent border on the main border.
3. Attach binding.
