

# Record

The Record function of the software allows you to create your own quilting pattern and save it for future use. Freehand your design, trace from a quilting stencil or printed quilting pattern. As you move the machine, creating your design, the software will Record the movement. When you are finished, simply save it in your software.

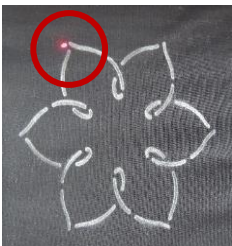
Prepare the method you will use for creating the design. If you are doing freehand, you are ready to start. If using a quilting stencil, mark your pattern onto your fabric. A chalk pounce is a quick and easy way to make sure the entire pattern is traced. Paper pattern, tape the pattern to the fabric so it will not move.



Open QCTv5 Software.  
Select Record




Attach laser to front of machine and turn laser on. Align laser light so that it shows on the pattern you are using.



You do not need to thread the machine for this. Remove bobbin case when running the machine without thread.

Tap on Start Recording and begin stitching. If you are using the laser light, make sure it is pointed at the lines on the pattern.

Touch Stop when finished. 

Tap on Save. 

Select pattern category – block, continuous line, etc. or select New and create a new folder.

Save your pattern. Now it is included in your pattern library for you to use.
