Pattern eClipse

This feature allows you to stitch a pantograph and select areas where you do not want the stitching to be. Stitch around appliques, embroidery designs, motifs, or other areas you do not want the machine to stitch the pantograph design in.

1. Open OCTv5 software. From the Home screen, touch Pantograph.

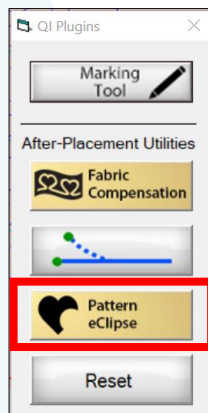
2. In Pantograph, you will be promoted to set the Safe Area. After you have set the Safe Area select Panto Mode > Power Panto.
3. Under Sizing > set the Total Width and Total Height of your quilt.
4. Select Pattern. Make any changes necessary for Pattern Height sizing, Spacing, Flip.
5. Save your pattern.
6. Select Sew in Zones. Go to Zone Manager  and select your choices for placement. Touch OK once you have made your selections. You are now in the Quilting Interface screen.
7. Follow the prompts to Place the pattern for sewing.

Note: You MUST place the pattern at this time. Do not skip over this step.

8. Touch Plug-ins in top right corner of screen.



9. Touch Pattern eClipse.

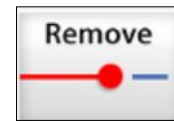
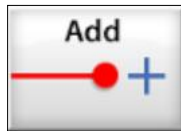


10. The zone you will be working with will be shown on the screen.

11. Adding Points around your design. These will be referred to as “Region”.

- a. Move your machine needle to the first area around your design. You can begin at the very edge of the design or you can begin $\frac{1}{4}$ ”, $\frac{1}{2}$ ”, etc. from the design. This is a personal preference.
- b. Touch the Add icon. Continue moving the machine needle around your design. Touch Add each time you need to set a point. Some designs will need more points than others will. For instance, a block will only require four (4) Add points, where a circular design will require more points to be set.

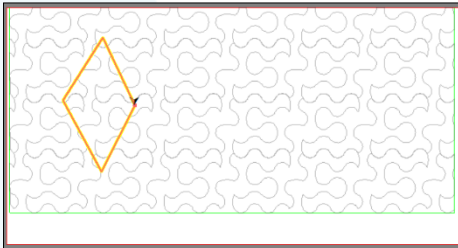
Note: if you select Add and decide that point was not needed, Touch Remove to delete that point.



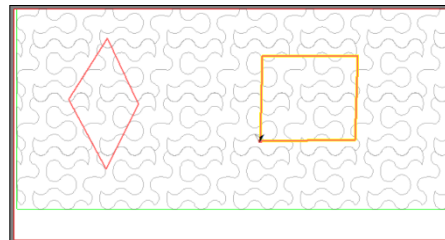
12. Use the magnifier, located at the top of the screen, to zoom in if needed.



13. As points are added, you will see a yellow line connecting those points.

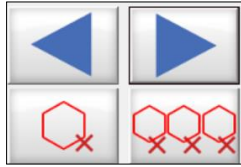


14. To start marking points around another design located in the same area as the zone you are currently stitching, touch New Region. Add points as you did for the previous shape/area. Repeat these steps for all areas that are in this stitching zone.



15. Editing eClipse areas.

- a. Touch the blue arrow to toggle between the designs.



- b. To delete ONE section touch, use the blue arrow to select the section, touch

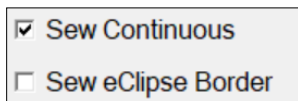


- c. To delete ALL sections, touch



16. You have a couple of choices regarding how you want to stitch around the designs.

- a. Sew Continuous > allows the pantograph to simply stitch around the design.



- b. Sew eClipse Border < stitches a border around the design.

17. Touch Preview to see how it will stitch out.



18. Close the Preview window.

19. Touch OK when ready to quilt.

20. Touch Sew to begin quilting. Follow prompts on screen to move to next row or section.

21. Roll the quilt to the next zone. Follow prompts to place the next zone for sewing.

22. Following the above instructions, create the eClipse around designs in the new sewing zone. You can delete the previous eClipse areas if desired.

23. Continue sewing adding eClipse areas as needed.
